Greetings,

We would like to take this opportunity to introduce you to the Cavalry Robotics Club. Our new club was established in 2016 and had an amazing inaugural year for the 5th-8th graders at Bishop Neumann, St. Wenceslaus, and St. John's Catholic Schools in Saunders County.

The Cavalry Robotics Club utilizes an innovative robotics design platform geared toward education in science, technology, engineering and math (STEM). It also helps provide the students with a project that encourages teamwork, leadership and problem-solving among the groups. Last year we had four (4) teams of 5-6 students per team, and the club not only achieved it's goal to participate in it's first competition in December 2016; but they also competed in a competition in January 2017. Three of the four teams qualified for Regionals in February of 2017 and one of the teams qualified for the US Open in April 2017.

As you can imagine, a Robotics Club has significant overhead costs to get started and maintained each year, so we are offering an opportunity for local businesses like yours to become Team/Club sponsors. Your contribution(s) will help us provide the parts necessary to build the robots, as well as programming them to compete in the competition.

The club is guided by a volunteer board and dedicated parent volunteers. Our primary source of revenue is through registration fees paid by the families and donations received from generous individuals and businesses. The average cost *per* team per year is \$3,500 to \$5,000.
