PROGRAM PHILOSOPHY: The mission of all Wahoo Parks and Recreation youth sports programs is to promote a fun, yet challenging environment in which participants are introduced to and taught the basics of a given sport. The program is strictly developmental in nature and emphasizes equal opportunity for involvement and participation.

REGISTRATION PERIOD: Now through July 11th. Register online by May 16th and receive an 'Early Bird' \$10 discount. Any registrations received after July 11th will incur a \$10 late fee and will only be accepted "as needed".

PROGRAM FORMAT: 2nd Grade, 3rd & 4th Grade, and 5th & 6th Grade leagues will be offered. All league matches will be played on Saturdays (primarily AM) and Monday evenings (only Wahoo or Mead teams would be scheduled for Monday nights if needed). League play will begin in late August/early September. All teams will play a round robin schedule and are guaranteed a minimum of six matches. All matches are played 6 vs. 6. EQUIPMENT: All players must wear tennis shoes with non marking soles. Volleyballs will be provided. Kneepads are recommended.

<u>UNIFORMS</u>: Youth participating in Wahoo Parks and Recreation youth sports are required to have and wear WPR approved attire (primarily blue/red Wahoo Parks and Rec shirts). Participating organizations/communities will need to have an approved shirt via league director.

<u>ROSTERS</u>: Wahoo team rosters are formed via school when necessary and possible with the intent of breaking up teams as evenly as possible. Parents may request their child be placed on a team with <u>one</u> other child for <u>legitimate</u> car pooling reasons. Some car pooling requests may not occur. This information needs to be indicated on the registration form (no exceptions). Once teams are formed, coaches are responsible for contacting players on their rosters to set up practices and distribute information. Participating organization/communities will also need to split team as evenly as possible. All rosters are subject to league director approval.

<u>COACHES</u>: Wahoo Parks and Recreation utilizes volunteer coaches for all youth sport programs. All head coaches are required to attend the coaches' meeting or meet with the league director. Instruction on general coaching philosophy and principles as well as sport-specific information will be discussed.

<u>SCHEDULES</u>: An important announcement regarding schedules and/or the release of schedules will be available August 16th on the WP&R website: www.wahoociviccenter.com.

MISCELLANEOUS: Participants and their parents/guardians should be aware that there is a risk of injury during participation in Wahoo Parks and Recreation youth sports due to the inherent nature of the activities. Individuals participate in Parks and Recreation youth sports at their own risk.

REFUNDS: Refunds will only be allowed if a child is unable to play due to injury. All refunds must be approved by Bob Schmidt.
