Info and Registration – Incoming 2nd through 6th grade

Who: Incoming 2nd – 6th grade St. John's and St. Wenc girls

Cost:

Option A: We are trying something new this year: Registration forms and fees for Cavalry Volleyball AND the Civic Center League will be turned in to Cavalry VB. Cavalry VB will then write one check to the Civic Center for all of our athletes. In turn, each player will receive a \$10 discount towards their Civic Center fees if forms are turned in by May 21st.

Cavalry VB fee: \$50; Civic Center League fee: \$20 (CC members; this is normally \$30) or \$35 (non-member; this is normally \$45)

Total Cost per player = \$70 (CC member) or \$85 (non-member) payable to Cavalry Volleyball

Includes:

- 6-8 instructional academies (evenings of July 2nd, 9th, 11th, 16th, & 25th, and August 1st, 2nd, & 3rd)
- Team practices for the Civic Center League (starting in August)
- Cavalry Volleyball t-shirt/jersey (used for tourney and league games)
- Cavalry Kickoff Volleyball Tourney (August 11th, 18th or 25th depending on when Civic Center League games start)

Option B: \$35 payable to Cavalry Volleyball. Due May 21st.

Includes:

- 6-8 instructional academies (evenings of July 2nd, 9th, 11th, 16th, & 25th, and August 1st, 2nd, & 3rd)
- Cavalry Volleyball t-shirt
