



## 2019-2020 Scholarship Information

Tuition has been set at \$2,000 for K-6<sup>th</sup> grades and \$3,200 for 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades in 2019-2020. Saunders Catholic Schools, through subsidized tuition and increased scholarships, will continue our long tradition of keeping tuition costs affordable for those in need of assistance. All families receive a substantially discounted tuition from the cost of education.

- The Good Shepherd Scholarship was announced by the Lincoln Diocese this year and is available to any family within 200% of the Federal Poverty Level. Scholarships are \$900 for grade school (K-8) and \$1,300 for high school (9-12).
- For any family that has three students in Saunders Catholic Schools, you will get an automatic full tuition scholarship for the fourth student and beyond, if you complete the FACTS application.
- For families within 200%-300% of the Poverty Level, that have three students, with at least one at Neumann, a Neumann Family Scholarship of approximately \$1,000 is available.
- In addition, all three schools have Guardian Angel Scholarship Programs, for those in need, who do not meet the Good Shepherd qualifications.
- The FACTS Grant & Aid Application will be used for all scholarships; you only need to apply once.

### Income Guidelines

The Income Guidelines will be published each year at [www.goodshepherdscholarship.com](http://www.goodshepherdscholarship.com), and are set to be 200% of the Federal Poverty Level. The Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) and your number of dependents from your Tax Form are used to determine the Household Size and Income Guidelines. You will need to submit copies of your 2017 or 2018 Tax Form and supporting documentation, such as W-2 Forms.

### Scholarship Application Deadline

The scholarship application deadline is **March 31, 2019**. You can apply for all scholarships at one time at [www.goodshepherdscholarship.com](http://www.goodshepherdscholarship.com) or at <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/4HMJ7>. There is a \$35 application fee per family.
