## Chicago Mission Trip Overview

Dates: June 1-6, 2020

Leaders: Kris Fairbanks & Teresa Urlacher

Cost: \$300; Plus \$100 Registration Fee

Prerequisite: Must be entering 10<sup>th</sup> Grade in Aug. 2020

Maximum # of Students: 30

Students leave Monday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, and drive to Chicago. Students work with the Missionary of Charity, the Little Sisters of the Poor, and the Franciscans of the Eucharist. Students stay at a Catholic grade school in Chicago. Mass is offered each day with time for reflection in the evenings. Students work in a soup kitchen, work at a homeless shelters, a food pantry, and an after school activity center for at risk youth. Students also bring meals to the homeless on the streets of Chicago, work with the disabled, and several other activities. Students arrive home late afternoon June 6th. Trip is managed by Bishop Neumann.

## New Mexico Mission Trip Overview

Dates: June 15-21, 2020 (Tentative)

Leaders: Roger Kuhfahl & Eva Fujan

Cost: \$300; Plus \$100 Registration Fee

Prerequisite: Must be entering 10<sup>th</sup> Grade in Aug. 2020

Maximum # of Students: 40

We will leave on Monday, June 15, and drive to Santa Fe, NM, where we work and stay one night. The next evening we drive to Gallup, NM. Mass is offered each day with time for reflection in the evenings. We work with the Missionaries of Charity, the Little Sisters of the Poor and the Diocese of Gallup. Activities include helping in soup kitchens, homeless shelters, working with the elderly, and working with children. This trip involves physical labor and working on maintenance and building projects. Students arrive home the evening of June 21st. Trip is managed by Bishop Neumann.

## St. Croix, USVI Mission Trip Overview

Dates: June 27 – July 3, 2020

Leaders: Eva Fujan & Gery Kenney

Cost: \$1,100; Plus \$100 Registration Fee (Includes Airfare)

Prerequisite: BNHS Mission Trip Alumni or Parent (Graduating Seniors, Alumni, and Parents)

Maximum # of Students: 15

This will be our first "International" trip. We will leave on June 27<sup>th</sup> and fly to St. Croix, US Virgin Islands. Since this island is a U.S. territory, **no passports are required!** However, if you already have a passport it's still a good idea to bring it along. If you do not have a passport, you are required to bring a valid government photo ID (Driver license). A third of the 104,700 residents live below the poverty line and the average annual income is approximately \$13,129. We will be working alongside the local Catholic Diocese as we help fix up local churches, visit with abused children, the elderly, and work with the disabled. We will enjoy creating art and playing games with nearby school children. We will fly back on July 3<sup>rd</sup> to the Omaha airport. ## Villa Marie Service Day

Villa Marie is a school for exceptional children that serves qualifying students who are in need of special educational services. Nestled in the beautiful Nebraska countryside between Lincoln and Waverly, it is a peaceful and inviting setting, providing a loving, family atmosphere for both day students and boarders. Bishop Neumann students set up and provide a one day camp for alumni of Villa Marie and work with the Marian Sisters doing maintenance work, cooking, and gardening. Students depart Neumann at 7:30am. The Alumni Camp will be 10:00-3:00 p.m. and will include mass. Return time to Neumann is 4:00 p.m.
