

Dual Credit offerings at Bishop Neumann High School 2019-2020

Honors Literature (Academic Transfer) NWU: English 1020 Composition, Language & Literature (3 credit hours) – In partnership with Nebraska Wesleyan University, Bishop Neumann offers a dual enrollment course to seniors in Honors Literature. To be eligible for the NWU Dual Enrollment Program, a student must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher. The student's guardian and Literature teacher must approve the registration. Tuition is paid directly to Wesleyan. The full year course at Bishop Neumann is offered for 3 credit hours through NWU.

Requirements:

- Seniors
- 3.0 cumulative GPA

Advanced Biology (Academic Transfer) NWU: Biology 1010: perspectives in Biological Science (4 credit hours) – In partnership with Nebraska Wesleyan University, Bishop Neumann offers a dual enrollment course to juniors and seniors. To be eligible for the NWU Dual Enrollment Program, a student must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher. The student's guardian and Advanced Biology teacher must approve the registration. Tuition is paid directly to Wesleyan. The full year course at Bishop Neumann is offered for 4 credit hours through NWU.

Requirements:

- Juniors and seniors
- 3.0 cumulative GPA

Religion III (Academic Transfer) NWU: Religion 2250: Religion, Peace and Social Justice (3 credit hours) – In partnership with Nebraska Wesleyan University, Bishop Neumann offers a dual enrollment course to juniors. To be eligible for the NWU Dual Enrollment Program, a student must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher. The student's guardian and Religion III teacher must approve the registration. Tuition is paid directly to Wesleyan. The full year course at Bishop Neumann is offered for credit hours through NWU.

NWU Course Description: Religion 2250: Religion, Peace and Social Justice (3)

This course explores religious responses to social justice issues such as conflict, poverty, oppression, discrimination, and the environment.

Requirements:

- Juniors
- 3.0 cumulative GPA

Music Theory (Academic Transfer) NWU: Music 1610 Fundamentals of Music Theory (3 credit hours) – In partnership with Nebraska Wesleyan University, Bishop Neumann offers a dual enrollment course to juniors and seniors. To be eligible for the NWU Dual Enrollment Program, a student must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher. The student's guardian and Music Theory teacher must approve the registration. Tuition is paid directly to Wesleyan. The full year course at Bishop Neumann is offered for 3 credit hours through NWU.

Requirements:

- Juniors or seniors
- 3.0 cumulative GPA

Southeast Community College – Distance Learning (Academic Transfer) – In partnership with SCC, Bishop Neumann students may earn dual credit in the courses listed below. To be eligible for these courses students must be a junior or senior with a 90% cumulative GPA, have an ACT score of 23 or higher on the math section, or have a grade of B or higher in Algebra II. Tuition is paid directly to SCC. Textbooks for any college classes are the responsibility of the student. Courses occur from 8:00 – 8:50am. These courses may not be used to replace graduation requirements at Bishop Neumann High School.

Requirements:

- Juniors or seniors
- 90% cumulative GPA
- ACT 23 Math or B in Algebra II

Fall semester course:

- Math 1150 College Algebra (M/W/F)

Spring semester course:

- Math 2170/BSAD 2170 Applied Statistics (M/W/F)

Southeast Nebraska Career Academy Partnership – SENCAP (Academic Transfer) – In partnership with SCC, Bishop Neumann offers a variety of dual credit courses involving various career pathways, to juniors and seniors. Students will explore a career field and get a first-hand look at what goes on in the “real world” by taking field trips, participating in job shadowing, listening to speakers, conducting research on careers of their interest, and experiencing other career exploration activities, many of which will be in their own communities. To be eligible for the SENCAP Career Academies, a student must have a 90% cumulative GPA and be a junior or senior. Tuition is paid directly to Southeast. Textbooks for any college classes are the responsibility of the student. Courses are in an online format. Courses can be taken in the fall and spring semesters. These courses may not be used to replace graduation requirements at Bishop Neumann High School.

Requirements:

- Juniors and Seniors
- 90% cumulative GPA

Southeast Community College – DC Advantage (Academic Transfer) – In partnership with SCC, Bishop Neumann offers a variety of dual credit courses to juniors and seniors. To be eligible for these courses students must be a junior or senior with a 90% cumulative GPA. Tuition is paid directly to SCC. Textbooks for any college classes are the responsibility of the student. Courses are in an online format. They can be taken in the fall and spring semesters. These courses may not be used to replace graduation requirements at Bishop Neumann High School.

Requirements:

- Juniors and Seniors
- 90% cumulative GPA

Southeast Community College – Distance Learning (Academic Transfer) – In partnership with SCC and Wahoo Public Schools, Bishop Neumann students may earn dual credit in the courses listed below. To be eligible for these courses students must be a senior with a 90% cumulative GPA. Tuition is paid directly to SCC. Textbooks for any college classes are the responsibility of the student. Students will register for these courses through Bishop Neumann but will attend classes at WHS in their Distance Learning classroom. Two elective choices are used for these courses. Courses occur from 2:00 – 3:15pm. These courses may not be used to replace graduation requirements at Bishop Neumann High School.

Requirements:

- Seniors
- 90% cumulative GPA

Fall semester courses:

- Intro to Public Speaking (M/W)
- Intro to Music (T/TH)

Projected spring semester courses:

- American History after 1877 (M/W)
- Comparative Religions (T/TH)

Concurrent Enrollment Classes at Bishop Neumann

NEBRASKA Now – In partnership with the University of Nebraska, Lincoln juniors and seniors are able to enroll in a variety of online college courses, preparing them for the transition from high school to college. To be eligible, juniors must have a 93% cumulative GPA and seniors must have a 90% cumulative GPA. If a student fails to meet this requirement, they may be considered if they have an ACT composite score of 22 or higher. The student's guardian and School Counselor must approve the registration. Student expenses include a \$45 application fee, tuition, and book/materials. Courses are presented in an online format. They can be taken in the fall and spring semesters.

Requirements:

- Juniors with a 93% cumulative GPA
- Seniors with a 90% cumulative GPA
- Juniors/Seniors with an ACT composite score of 22 or higher

Catholic through the Ages: Making the World a Better Place – In partnership with St. Cecilia High School and Nebraska Wesleyan University, junior and senior students may enroll in this online course that focuses on the literary accomplishments of Catholic authors. To be eligible for the NWU Honors Academy, a student must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher. The student's guardian and School Counselor must approve the registration. Tuition is paid directly to Wesleyan and St. Cecilia High School (currently \$100 plus \$65 book rental if necessary). Three credit hours will be given through NWU upon successful completion. Course is presented in an online format.

Requirements:

- Juniors and seniors
- 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher
