IMPORTANT SCHOOL INFORMATION

- **The school year will begin on Wednesday, August 11th at 8:00 a.m. with dismissal at 3:25. Students who walk to school or who are dropped off do not need to be at school before 7:45 a.m.** Adult supervision is not available outside on a regular basis and the school cannot be held responsible for accidents that may occur between students because they are here too early. The first bell rings at 7:46 a.m. for students to enter the building and the tardy bell will ring at 8:00 a.m..
- **DUE TO THE NEW ADDITION CONSTRUCTION the traffic flow for morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up will be quite a bit different from the way it was before. We have been working on this plan since April. Once the plan is in place we will send out an email sometime before school begins.**
- **The bus schedule is arranged and run by Neumann High School. Bus fees are \$500.00 per family payable to Neumann High School.** We can collect the payment at St. Wenceslaus but it must be a separate check made payable to Neumann High School. Questions concerning busing should be directed to the Neumann office. Students who will be riding the Wahoo Public School bus need to contact Wahoo Public Schools to notify them and be put on their route. Our students who ride the Public School bus are dismissed from classes in time to make the bus. We do not have a schedule for the Wahoo Public buses. Please call Wahoo Public Schools for this information.
- **Each School family will be mailed a statement for the 2021-2022 school year recently.** Please contact our office if you did not receive a statement. If you have selected the 4 payment plan or the ten month payment plan with Facts Tuition Management, those electronic payments will begin in the month of July. Whatever payment choice you make is fine with us as long as you honor the choice you make and keep current with the payments. The school relies upon your financial support to pay our bills and to keep the school fully operational. If you would like to get a jump-start on the full payment you can mail your payments into the office. A receipt of your payments will be sent home the first week of school. The school office will be open daily beginning August 2nd (9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.). You may also pay these fees the first day of school in the office, however, the first day is always so hectic that it would be much easier to take care of this ahead of time. Please remember that bus fees, school fees and lunch checks must all be handled with separate checks because they all go to different accounts. Bus and lunch checks are payable to Neumann High School. You can leave them with us and we will deliver them to the right places. Student school fees are payable to St. Wenceslaus. Thanks for your help and understanding in this matter.
- **Emergency information cards will be sent home the first week of school.** Parents, please take time to fill out **all** the blanks. All the information asked for is needed for our records. Please find the answer to **all** the blanks on the form **before** returning it to school.
- **The St. Wenceslaus School Open House will be held on Wednesday, August 4th from 5:00-7:00 p.m.** This will give each parent or guardian an opportunity to bring in their child(ren)'s supplies, meet their teacher(s) and get an idea of the expectations for the school year. It will also be an opportunity to meet the parents of the other students in the same classroom.
- **Requirement for volunteers for any school activity** – The Diocese of Lincoln requires each volunteer at our school (field trips, room parents, reading aides, lunch and recess helpers, etc) to have a background check. If you have had a background check done with your employer recently and can provide us the paperwork for that, please let us know. If you have not had a background check done by your employer you will need to go through the Diocesan program (Safe Environment Training Program). The Diocese requires the Safe Environment training to be completed once a year by all volunteers. Please contact the school and we will provide you with the information needed to get this training accomplished.

- **The Parent/Student Handbooks will be sent home with your child(ren) the first week of school.** Everyone needs to read through it and review the various policies and procedures that keep our school running smoothly. A new verification form is attached to the back for you and your child/ren to sign after you have read through the book. Young children may print their first name. This form should be returned to the office as soon as possible.
- **We want to thank all those who have been saving the various labels and receipts for us during the year.** We have received various school items and cash donations as a result of your efforts. There are boxes in the school office and the back of St. Wenceslaus Church for the collection of these labels. We appreciate your effort in saving these and urge you to continue.
- **The St. Wenceslaus School Office will be closed from July 5th through July 30th.** School forms and payments can be mailed during this time as mail will be checked on a daily basis. Messages on the answering machine will also be checked and phone calls returned in a timely manner.
- **Please let our School Office know immediately if your child's name is miss-spelled or has been omitted** from a class list. This was not intentional and we apologize for any error we may have made.
- **If you child has had shots over the summer months,** please bring or mail the updated information to the School Office.
- **Change of mailing address, email address or phone number?** Please notify the school office.
- **Families are encouraged to send us your email address(es).** Many reminders through the school year are sent via email. Paper reminders will be sent home to those parents who do not have an email address. Please send questions or information to colleen-chvatal@cdolinc.net

Students with specific Health concerns/diagnosis/medications: If your child has a specific health concern or diagnosis that needs monitoring and you want us to be aware of an action plan for your child – please contact our office. We would like to schedule a 15 minute appointment for you to meet with office personnel, your child's teacher(s) and classroom aide before the school year begins. **We will schedule these meetings on Monday, August 9th between 3:00 and 6:00 p.m.** Please bring any medications, supplies and paperwork with you to the meeting. Your child is welcome to accompany you. You must call our office or email colleen-chvatal@cdolinc.net ahead of time to schedule the meeting so that teachers and aides can be advised as to the exact time of the meeting. Colleen will get in touch with you to verify the time. Each meeting will begin promptly at the scheduled time and conclude according to the schedule so we can meet with all families in one evening and keep all families and faculty/staff on schedule. Thank you.

Parents of new students in kindergarten through the sixth grade – please try to turn in enrollment forms and immunization records by July 16th if possible. It takes several hours to organize papers and create a cumulative folder for new students. Your help in turning these forms in helps us have the folders ready by the first day of school. Thank you.

St. Wenceslaus Catholic School Dress Code

Shirts (girls and boys)

PLAIN RED or WHITE dress shirts or polo shirts. These can be short or long sleeve.

They must have a collar and must be tucked in at all times.

The company insignia or logo of 1" or less is permitted.

Any short or long sleeved T-shirts worn underneath must be of the same color as the dress/polo shirt they are wearing.

Shorts (girls and boys)

Shorts should be BLACK and **must be purchased from the Dennis Uniform Company. These are allowed to be worn starting in the Spring on April 1st and ending in the Fall on November 1st.**

Pants (girls and boys)

Pants should be BLACK slacks or corduroys.

They must have four or less pockets and the pockets must be on the upper portion of the pants and not on the legs.

Pants cannot be rolled up, be torn or have any holes in them.

Girls may also wear LOOSE FITTING stretch pants in place of slacks.

**These pants are usually made out of cotton & spandex. If they "LOOK LIKE" or "FEEL LIKE" sweat pants then please do not have your daughter wear them to school. These types of pants can be purchased at a variety of stores such as Target, Walmart, Sears, JC Penney, etc. If you have any questions please stop by school and we would be happy to show you samples that we have on hand.*

****NOTE: All pants/slacks MUST have a zipper and button/snap!!!**

Black leggings may be worn under jumpers during cold weather.

However, leggings are not considered uniform pants and should not be worn alone.

Jumpers and skorts (girls only)

School jumper for grades K-6; Belair Plaid in color **and must be purchased from the Dennis Uniform Company.**

The jumper style is a shift with a v-neck or high neck collar. Not a romper.

When wearing jumpers shorts must be worn underneath and jumpers must be long enough in length to cover the shorts

Black or Dark Navy Blue leggings may be worn under jumpers during cold weather

Black skorts must be purchased from the Dennis Uniform and are optional for 5th & 6th grade girls. **They are allowed to be worn starting on April 1st and ending on November 1st.** NOTE: Leggings are not allowed to be worn underneath skorts or uniform shorts.

Sweatshirts (girls and boys)

GREY Crew Neck sweatshirt with or without St. Wenceslaus Logo or Dukes logo

RED Crew neck sweatshirt with St. Wenceslaus Logo or Bishop Neumann Logo which is same one worn by Bishop Neumann students

RED half or full zip fleece jacket with either St. Wenceslaus Logo or Bishop Neumann Logo

*Shirts must be worn under all sweatshirts and sweaters.

** Order forms for the items above will be available in the school office.

Shoes and Socks (girls and boys)

PREDOMINANTLY WHITE or BLACK socks of any style must be worn (no other colors will be allowed).

Tennis shoes must be worn at all times throughout the school day. **NO BOOTS CAN BE WORN IN THE CLASSROOMS.**

NOTE: During winter months boots can be worn to school but the student must bring tennis shoes with them to change into while they are at school.

Miscellaneous

Girls may wear earrings. However, large showy dangling earrings or earrings in places other than the ear are not allowed.

Boys are not allowed to wear earrings.

Girls are allowed to wear "simple" headbands or barrettes to help keep their hair out of their face

Haircuts for boys should be simple, clean, and neatly kept with NO hair coloring and/or dyeing.

Note: "Simple" means NO DESIGNS, NO MOHAWKS, NO LINES, etc.....

There is to be no permanent or semi-permanent foreign objects attached to hair or head (example = feathers or extensions)

Girls are not allowed to wear any type of make-up, lipstick and/or eye shadow.

The administration will make any changes and/or additions to the dress code. If there are any questions/concerns in regards to the dress code please contact the administration or a member of the St. Wenceslaus School Advisory Board.
